



TENANCY SUSTAINMENT SERVICE FOR SURVIVORS of SEXUAL ABUSE (TS4S)

Are you a survivor of sexual abuse?

Are you 16-25 years old female and a tenant or a potential tenant?

You may benefit from talking to a specialist service for survivors who will help you to sustain your tenancy and avoid homelessness.

SAY Women and Renfrewshire Youth Service are working together to develop a service to meet the needs of female survivors.

SAY Women is a charity organisation and works with young females (16-25 years old) to assist on their way of recovery from sexual violence, rape, sexual assault and abuse, and to minimise their risk of homelessness.

We recognise survivor's needs can and will impact on managing a tenancy.

SAY Women will listen and help to draw on survivor's strengths to build a plan to sustain a tenancy.
